A pre-Advent Christmas project to get people talking and thinking about Jesus, and the true, miraculous 'reason for the season'!



Around 500 pebbles (rocks!) with the image of Mary (see attached picture) will be hidden around the parish for people to find when they are out and about.

On the back of the rocks will be written the church website (www.stsaviourschurch.org), the church email (stsaviourschurch@cwgsy.net) and social media information (#maryrocksguernsey).

When people find the rocks they can engage both with our church website and our social media pages and social media campaign which will be running alongside the hunt.

Hunting for stones will take place 14th - 28th November, with a 'rock concert' family celebration service on **Sunday 28th November at 3pm.** (Advent Sunday). At this service we will give families information about our Christmas services, and invite them along! We are aiming to engage as many people as possible with the Christmas story.
