clothing please!**

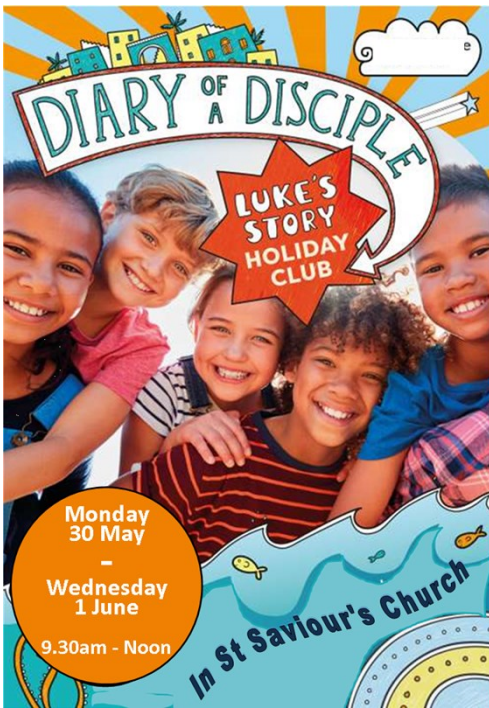

Our opening hymn on Easter Sunday "Jesus Christ is risen today, alleluia!"

They are the central truths of our faith.

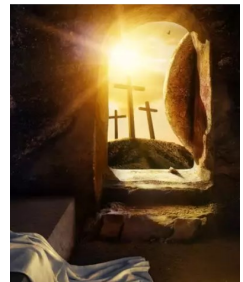
And as Paul says to the church in Corinth who were arguing whether bodily resurrection was possible;
"If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins." (I Cor 15 v.17)

Once you are dead, you're dead – it's the normal way of things.
