### Thought for the month....

At the Last Supper Jesus washed the Disciples feet, showing them the importance of serving others, a challenge that is there for us too.

Jesus instigated communion, instructing them to keep doing this until his return, and this remembrance passes on to the church, us, to faithfully continue.



And finally Jesus gave the Disciples some teaching; "I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another." (John 13 vs.34), which again passes on to us.

Bishop Westcott, Bishop of Durham from 1890 to 1901 wrote this prayer:

Almighty God and most merciful Father, Who has given us a new commandment that we should love one another, give us also grace that we may fulfil it. Make us gentle, courteous and forbearing. Direct our lives so that we may look each to the good of the other in word and deed. And hallow all our friendships by the blessing of your Spirit, For his sake who loved us and gave himself for us. Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
